- A1** Write down the equation of the tangent to $y^2 = 4ax$ at the point $(at^2, 2at)$, and state the gradient of the normal there. [2]

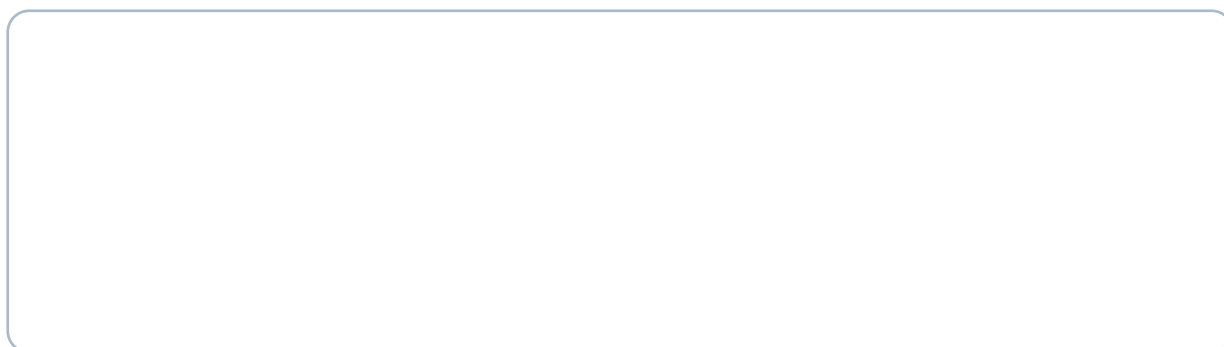
- A2** Find the equation of the tangent to $y^2 = 16x$ at the point where $t = 2$. [3]
